Visual images convey powerful messages to students, practitioners, family members and individuals in ways text and voice cannot. Videos about aging and older adults are used to instruct gerontology students, health care professionals, and social service professionals for many years. Self-instructional videos have been developed to educate family caregivers, baby boomers, and active older adults. Videos are also used in senior centers, nursing homes and other residential settings as aides in reminiscence therapy. More recently, public, cable and commercial broadcast stations have supported the production of public awareness videos to document changes in our aging society.
